Our new topic is...Global Treasures

This half term we are moving on to our Global Treasures unit, where we explore all the treasures of the world - in year 5 we will be facusing on Shakespeare and The Vikings over this half term!

As mathematicians, we will finish our unit on fractions and use our multiplication skills to multiply fractions. We will then move onto our unit on decimals.
