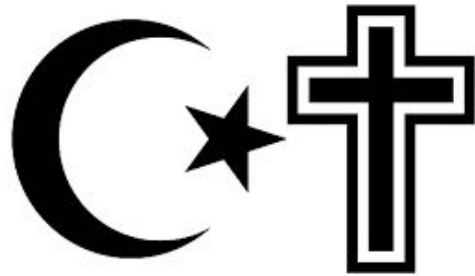


RELIGIOUS EDUCATION
