## This week's learning..

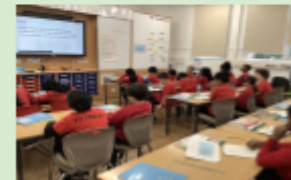
This week in Year 5 we are delving a little deeper into Black History and learning all about how rights evolved over time!
