Head Teacher Message:

I am sure that most parents/carers will be very concerned that London has been put into Tier 2. This will mean some more restrictions in place regarding how you conduct your daily lives. There is no suggestion that schools will be affected and we will continue to operate under all the current arrangements we have in place. Children should come to school everyday, unless they are ill, display covid symptoms or are in a collapsed bubble and are doing learning from home.

Yesterday we had to collapse the Reception year group bubble. I understand parents concerns about having to go to work, but I must remind you that these children need to self-isolate indoors for 14 days. This is a really important strategy to slow down the spread of the virus and is now a legal requirement. Failure to self-isolate can result in a £1000 fine.

What does Tier 2 restrictions mean?

- No households can mix indoors.
- Maximum of 6 now applies to Outdoors.
- Pubs and restaurants will close at 10pm.
- Avoid unnecessary travel.
- Schools remain open!



Meeting up with family you don't live with?



- Maximum of 6 people at any one time
- Keep a two metre distance between each household or bubble
- It's safer to meet outdoors

What can you do to help the school:

- Always wear a mask on site.
- Make sure only one adult/sibling comes to drop off and collect pupils.
- Avoid speaking to staff - use the year group emails (for specific concerns) and the info email (for general issues).
- Make sure your child has a good healthy breakfast with some additional vitamins.
- Help your child to log on to the live teaching sessions to keep up with their learning. We can help you with this. Call the school office and ask for a one to one telephone appointment.

Attendance

Unless they are ill, children must come to school everyday. If they have a brother or sister in a collapsed bubble, who is well and without any symptoms, they must attend school. Please call us to help with any concerns you may have regarding attendance.
