P.E is on **Monday**

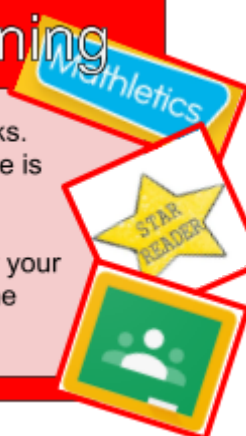
Fit Friday is on **Friday**.
