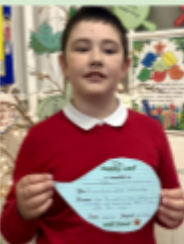
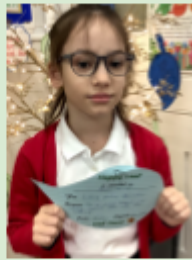
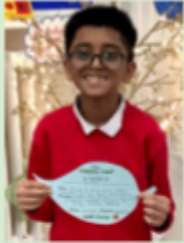
Year 5 Newsletter
