This term our focus is on positive relationships and our Happy Leaves last week went to:

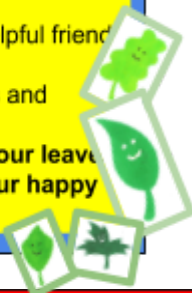
2B: Marni for being such a kind and caring friend.

We have a brand new Science Home Learning Project coming soon so keep your eyes out in the newsletters!

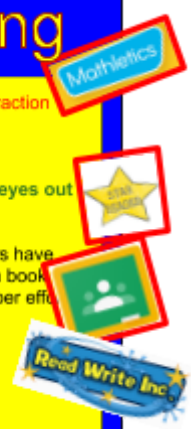
