This weeks learning..

In our English lessons the children will be creating a factfile. We have been learning about the Industrial Revolution and this week the children will be looking at how some children were sent to the workhouse, why they were sent there and what life was like. They have already participated in our interactive lesson through Now Press Play and are beginning to have an understanding of what life was like.



We are continuing our Maths - No Problem! scheme and this week the children will be looking at addition within 10,000. The children will work in their workbooks and demonstrate their understanding of their learning in their maths journals.

The children will beginning their Design and Technology unit. We will be making lightboxes. The children will learn how they work and will be making their own over the coming weeks. They will design make and evaluate their box and use wood to create the structure and make an electrical circuit to illuminate their sign. We look forward to sharing these with you.

As scientists the children will be investigating melting and freezing. They will investigate the temperature chocolate, butter and cooking fat melts and how long it takes them to solidify.
