This week in Year 5 we have had the opportunity to use the Now Press Play software to understand what life was like for evacuee children during WW2.

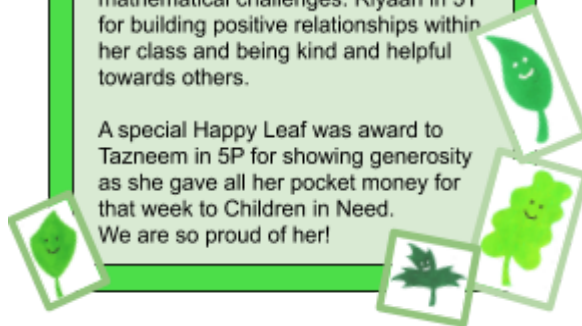


We also celebrated Inter Faith Week by creating our very own mug based on our religion or personal beliefs.
