In science we found objects that were made of more than one material and explored how many different materials some objects are made from. To push us to be the best at materials, at home you could describe different things for example: "Hard, silver metal."



In Mathematics, we looked at making 10. We challenged ourselves and looked at missing numbers and how we could find out what it was. We learnt that counting on is the best way to solve a missing number problem. For Example:

$$4 + \square = 10$$

$$7 + \square = 10$$
