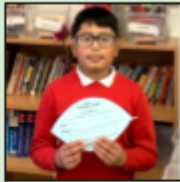

This week in Year 5 we had the opportunity to create informative videos advising the National History Museum's recovery team how they can move the meteorite out of the crater using a lever and pulley system!

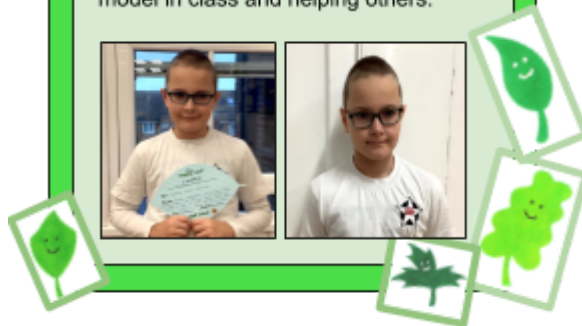
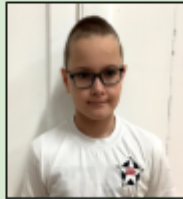
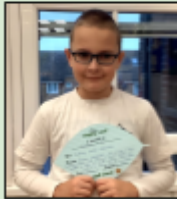


This week the Happy Leaves were awarded to:
