Last weeks learning...

In maths last week we looked at subtraction. We used crossing out to help us subtract a number from a group. Just like this:

This helps us to see that $7 - 2 = 5$.

We then moved onto subtracting by jumping backwards on a number line.

Subtract by Crossing Out



In Geography, we used atlases and Digimap to find where the UK is in the world. We then had a look at our local area and some of us even spotted our houses! You could use Google Earth at home and see if you can spot anyone else's house, or even some of the famous landmarks in London.



We also conducted an experiment to find out what was the best material to make a rain coat with. We found out that materials have to be waterproof to make a good raincoat. See if you can look around the house and spot any waterproof materials!
