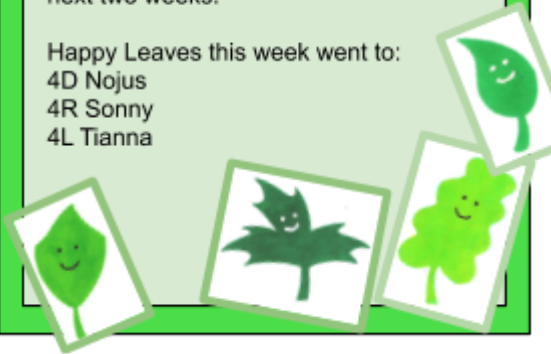
STAR moments

This was a perfect problem for our science lesson this week as the children were learning about evaporation. They conducted an experiment and will be writing to the manager next week to explain their findings.

This week is assessment week across the school. The children in year 4 will have two reading comprehensions, a grammar and spelling test to complete.

We are continuing our Maths - No Problem! scheme and this week will continue looking at subtraction within 10,000. The children will work in their workbooks and demonstrate their understanding of their learning in their maths journals.

As mentioned, the children will be recording and analysing the findings of the experiment they did last week and letting the local football manager know the best way to dry his team's kit.

Christmas Cards

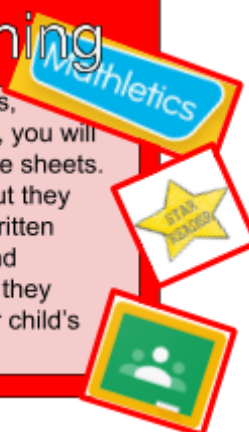
