In geography, we will take a closer look at the Amazon rainforest and looking at its physical features. Our live foundation lesson this week is science where we will be looking at how many different animals can live in one place. On Tuesday the children will participate in live music and P.E. lessons with Mrs Marshall and Mrs Bennett, you will find your class timings on the timetable on classroom.

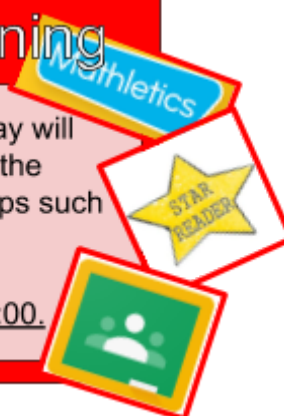
Don't forget!
