A fantastic start to our remote learning. It has been wonderful to see all the children working so hard in virtual school - and dressed in their uniforms. We are really proud of you!

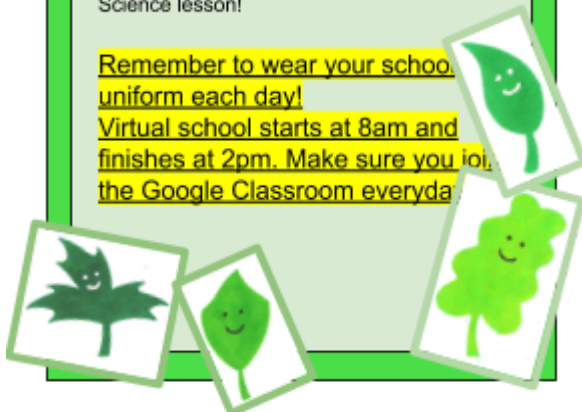
This week's happy leaves go to:

Online learning this week is..

Log on to the Google Classroom. Read any comments in the class stream and click on the classwork tab to find this week's learning.

As mathematicians we will be continuing to learn about percentages and solving word problems. We will also be learning how to find the percentages of different amounts. We will look at equivalent percentages, fractions and decimals before moving onto our new topic about measures.

As writers, we will be exploring the moral of a tale called The Lorax; respect for the environment and sustainability. We will be linking this to Article 24 which states that every child has the right to a clean and healthy environment. We will then be writing a persuasive letter as the Lorax to the protagonist of the story.

As readers, we will be reading some excerpts from narratives to practice our inference skills! We will also be reading all about the effects of climate change and what we can do to help slow these down!

In RHSE, we will be continuing to focus on coping skills and figuring out which skills we can use to cope in different situations.

As scientists, we will be researching the impact of climate change on different animals and how they can adapt to surviving the changing climate.

In Geography, we will be learning about tectonic plates and will be plotting them on a world map.

In RE, we will be learning about Hindu beliefs on life and death.
