On Tuesday the children will participate in live music and P.E. lessons with Mrs Marshall and Mrs Bennett, you will find your class timings on the timetable on classroom.

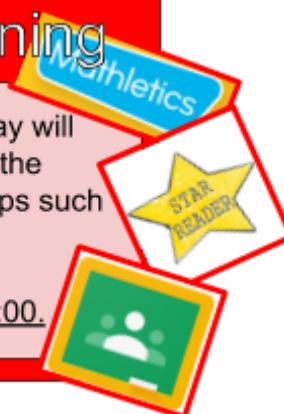
Don't forget!
