The class with the best online attendance this week is 6R with 89%. Let's aim for 100% next week everyone!

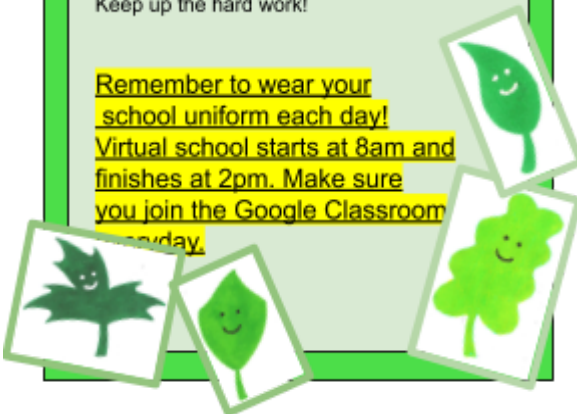
This week's happy leaves go to:

Online learning this week is...

Log on to the Google Classroom. Read any comments in the class stream and click on the classwork tab to find this week's learning.

We will continue with measurements and use our knowledge of multiplying and dividing by 10, 100 and 100 to converting between different units of measure.

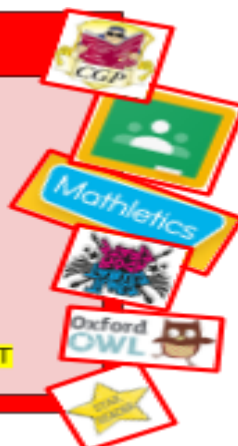
