This week's online learning:

This week in English, we will be delving into our topic of climate change by exploring the impact this has on our environment. We will gather facts and explore different writing genres to present this information. What do you already know about climate change?

As Mathematicians, we will continue to look at the key features and vocabulary of word problems, for both multiplication and division. Towards the end of the week, we will also be starting out new chapter.

As Geographers, we will be creating a fact file on the foods that are grown in Spain. We will research how different climates produce different types of food.

As Scientists, we are looking at seed dispersal and how seeds travel around in different ways. Can you research a specific flower and find out how it disperses its seeds?

In Big Reading, we will continue reading *The Vanishing Rainforest*. We will deepen our understanding through comparing and contrasting characters, exploring problems the characters face and using the text to create the setting we see in our mind.

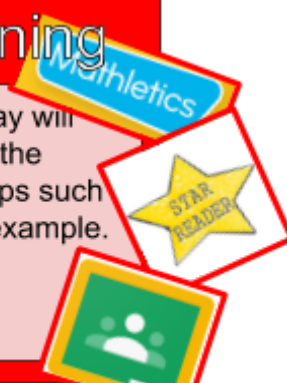
Don't forget!
