## This week's online learning:

This week we will continue with our Spanish lessons. Please see your child's class timetables to see when they need to join. They will begin at 8.00am on whichever day your child's class has this lesson and all children are expected online at this time.

In English this week we will be learning some more on persuasive techniques and the children will learn how to participate in a debate and learning how to persuade others to see their point of view. The next couple of weeks may get a little heated! All English lessons are live this week. In maths this week we will continue looking at division and the children will complete a mental maths and an arithmetic test. All maths lessons are live this week.

During our foundation lessons in the afternoon we will continue R.E. looking at the Hindu religion and how Hindus worship at home. In geography the children will continue their work on the Amazon and looking deeper into deforestation. Science will be a live lesson this week and the children will learn how animals get their food. Laughology is another of our live lessons on Friday where the children will be learning about coping skills. 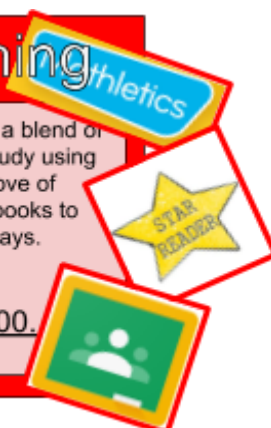
## Over to you...Home learning
