## Online learning this week is...

As mathematicians we will be beginning to explore how data is represented in Maths. We will be using train timetables to interpret data and using it to answer questions. We will then be moving on to line graphs and begin to see how data is plotted on the graph.

In English, we will start to explore our exciting new topic: climate change! We will be getting to grips with its causes and effects as well as producing some persuasive and descriptive writing. As readers, we will be continuing our book, 'Kick'; analysing settings and emotions as well as exploring the author's use of Indonesian vocabulary. Our grammar this week will be about homophones - words that are spelt the same and sound the same, but have different meanings.

In RE, we will be listening to the story of 'Jonah and the Whale' and identifying what a believer might learn from the religious story.

As scientists, we will be exploring how the plants in our solar system move and how this affects us on Earth.

In RSHE, we will be learning all about our brain and how it has evolved over many years.

As geographers, we will be looking into how humans have treated California and the effects of human activity on the natural environment.

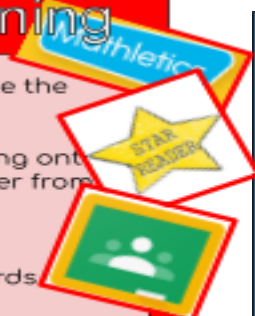
