Online learning this week is...

As readers, we will be looking at a variety of descriptive texts and practicing our inference skills.

As writers, we will be continuing with writing our own narratives which like all good authors, we will edit and improve to make sure that we have included all the features of narrative writing. We will then write up our stories in an extended Big Writing lesson.

As mathematicians, we will be learning how to calculate the perimeter and area of 2D shapes. These will include shapes such as squares, rectangles, parallelograms and triangles. Children will then solve a range of word problems on perimeter and area towards the end of the week.

As scientists, we will be looking at the effects of climate change on coral reefs and the impact to animals that call the reefs home.

As geographers, we will be learning about the features of volcanoes and drawing cross section diagrams to demonstrate them.

In RSHE we will be continuing to develop our growth mindset. We will be looking at how we can show growth mindset in different situations and how we can use power poses to help accomplish this!

In RE, we will be learning about what Muslims believe about life after death and we will compare Islam and other main religions: Hinduism and Catholicism.

In Spanish we will learn how to express feelings (estoy + adjective), introduce ourselves (Hola, me llamo...) and tell our age (Hola, me llamo Carlos y tengo + age)
