This week's online learning:

This week in English, we will learn how food is linked to climate change and explore different diets that may reduce carbon emissions.

As Mathematicians, we are delving further into multiplication and division. We are starting to think about multiplying 2 digit numbers!

As Geographers, we will be comparing trade (buying and selling of goods) from the past to the present whilst exploring how trade has changed over the years.

As Scientists, we are looking at the differences between fruits and vegetables. Do you know the difference? For this lesson, it would be really helpful if you could have a piece of fruit that an adult can help you to cut open!

In RSHE this week, we will continue learning about Coping Skills with a specific focus on Mantras and how we can use them.

In Big Reading, we will finish reading *The Vanishing Rainforest*. We will develop our reading skills of skimming and scanning to find different sentence openers and verbs. We will distinguish between fact and opinion and we will practise skimming and scanning to find information to answer questions.

In RE, we will continue exploring the Hindu Festival of Holi, learning about Hinduism belief in God. We will explore Brahma, Vishnu and Shiva.

Our LIVE Spanish lessons will continue this week! What things can you remember from last week?

Please note that P.E and Music will still run on a Wednesday afternoon each week. The children access these lessons through their Google Classroom accounts as they would do for their other LIVE lessons. They will be shared 5 - 10 minutes before each lesson. A gentle reminder for parents to ensure that the children understand what is expected of them during each of the live lessons.

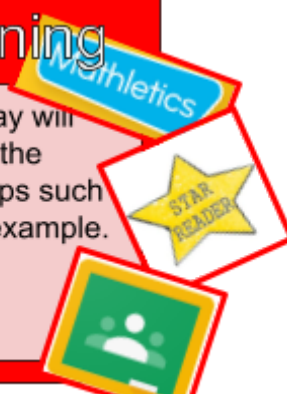
- Make sure that all children are dressed appropriately for their learning (no PJs)
