Attend all of your online lessons every day.

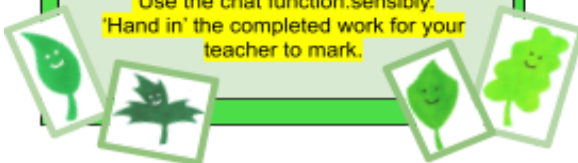
Wear your school uniform.

Online learning this week is...

Log on to the Google Classroom. Read any comments in the class stream and click on the classwork tab to find the learning.

As mathematicians, we will consolidate our learning on finding the area and perimeter of 2D shapes. Our focus will then move onto triangles; recapping on finding the area as well as identifying their different properties. We will use correct mathematical terminology to name triangles and calculate the value of missing angles.

In English, we will be writing non-chronological reports about volcanoes. We will explore the key features of non-fiction texts and research our topic to gather as many interesting facts as we can to make our reports informative and exciting to read. We will write our reports using technical vocabulary, headings and subheadings.

As readers, we will be looking at the vocabulary used in different texts, both fictional and non-fictional, and thinking about why the author has made these choices.

In RSHE, we will be looking at how/when we should use our coping skills and creating a coping plan for the future.

As scientists, we will be investigating how climate change impacts mammals and how they can adapt to survive in extreme temperatures.

As geographers, we will be investigating the advantages and disadvantages of living near a volcano!

In RE, we will be exploring what people of the Sikh faith believe about life after death.

In Spanish, we will apply our knowledge of numbers from 1 to 10 to count different school equipment.
