RC: Areesha for always being so cheerful and working well all the way from Pakistan.

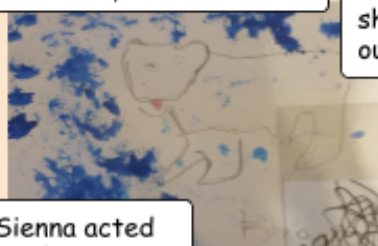
RP: Lucas for gaining confidence during live lessons.

Our book this week is 'A Polar Bear's Home.' Eshaq has created a brilliant polar bear!



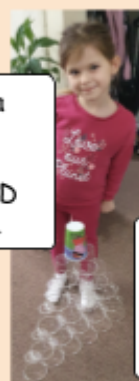
Erik went 3D shape hunting outside.



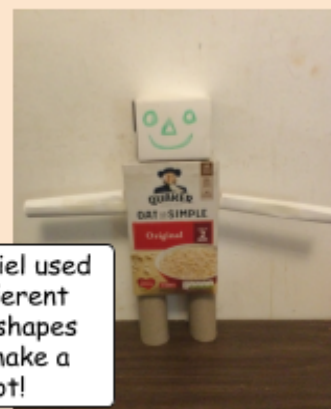
Sienna acted out how a flower grows beautifully!
