## This week's online learning:

This week in English, this is our final week focusing on climate change and we are going to be writing persuasive speeches! What will you include in yours?

As Mathematicians, we are continuing to look at division as well as exploring different methods we could use to help us.

As Geographers, we will be creating a presentation summary of our topic this past term. We will recap on where our food comes from, trade, weather climates and the natural resources that Earth offers.

As Scientists, we will be looking into and describing the stages of how a plant produces fruit. We will also be going back to our Thinking Frame from lesson 1 to add all the important information we have learnt about during this topic.

In RSHE this week, we are concluding our learning on Coping Skills. Can we create a 'recipe' for coping?

In Big Reading, this week we will start with a LIVE shared read of our Big Reading text together as a whole class, followed by demonstrating our understanding of the book through the creation of a game and a Kahoot Quiz!
