**6R: Alisha** - For producing a well-researched non-chronological report on volcanoes which she has edited and improved. Well done Alisha.

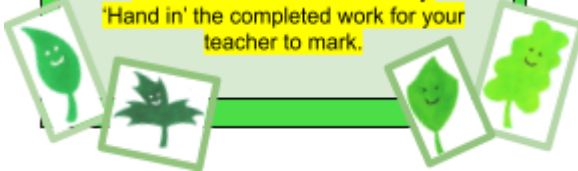
**6E: Amira** - for responding so well to teacher feedback as part of her online learning, especially with Maths and English! Well done Amira!

## Online learning this week is...

As writers, we will complete our non-chronological reports on volcanoes by creating a glossary of technical vocabulary. We will be writing and presenting a well-balanced argument on our topical debate 'Causes of climate change - human activity or a natural eventuality?'

As readers, we are continue to work on our vocabulary skills by looking at some excerpts from narratives. We are also going to look at ways in which we can help the environment!

As mathematicians, we will be calculating missing angles in quadrilaterals and on a straight line. We will also be naming the different types of angles and find other ways to classify 2D shapes. Moving on, we will look at the properties of circles and finding the volume of 3D shapes.

**Safer Internet Day - Tuesday 9th February.** This year's theme is 'An Internet We Trust.' We will have a special assembly and an afternoon where we will explore why the internet is not always reliable and what we can do to make it more trustworthy.
