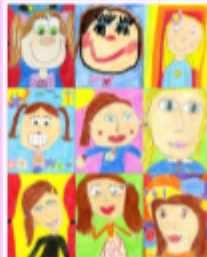

I am 8 toy cars tall.



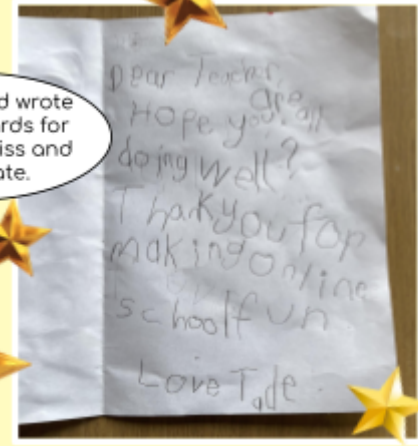
We made pictures for people we love and appreciate.
