This week's online learning:

This week in English we will be exploring our new topic Express Yourself! Be ready to discuss your favourite stories and characters!

As Mathematicians, we are starting a brand new chapter and will begin by looking at mass and comparing weights between objects.

As Geographers, we will be looking at the United Kingdom and plotting the major cities and counties that are around London.

As Scientists, we will be starting our new topic of Forces and Magnets. The first lesson will be about the different forces that make objects move.
