The class with the best attendance this week is 5ON!

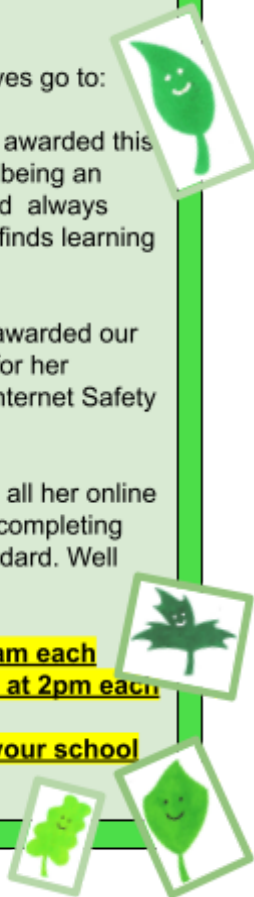
This week's happy leaves go to:

EXPRESS YOURSELF!

Log on to the Google Classroom. Read any comments in the class stream and click on the classwork tab to find this week's learning.

As mathematicians, we will be continuing our exploration of fractions and this week we will be focusing on ordering and comparing fractions. We will also be looking at number pairs - like number bonds, but with fractions!

In English, we will start to explore our exciting new topic: Express Yourself! We will be exploring the ways in which we can express ourselves through storytelling and poetry. As readers, we will be continuing our book, 'Kick'; the story will be taking a new interesting turn, where Budi will enter the dragons house accidentally. Our grammar this week will be about pronouns - words that replace a noun to avoid repetition.

In RE, we will be listening to the story of 'Jonah and the Whale' and identifying what a believer might learn from the religious story.

As scientists next half term we will be looking at the properties of materials and how we can change them! To make sure we can do this we will be looking at the states of matter and how they differ from one another. After that we will begin to compare materials by their properties, such as if they're magnetic, their hardness, the transparency and their conductivity.

In RSHE, we will be learning all about what success is. What do we define as an achievement and how can we celebrate them?

As geographers, we will be looking into how coasts are formed. We will be recapping the features of a river and identifying key features on rivers such as the Rhine and the Thames.

In computing we will be looking at our online image and how we present ourselves online.

In Art we will be starting to look at world famous artist Vincent Van Gogh and his work in Post-Impressionism. Why not research him over the half term? You could find a new favourite painting!
