## STAR moments

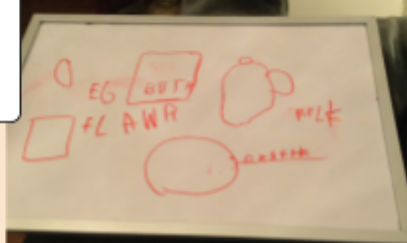
Look at what we were up to in school and home last week:
