Online learning this week...

Log on to the Google Classroom. Read any comments in the class stream and click on the classwork tab to find this week's learning.

As mathematicians, we will be exploring methods of adding fractions using bar models and real-life scenarios. We will then move on to subtracting fractions using the same methods, as well as continuing our practice of simplifying fractions.

This week on Thursday we will be celebrating World Book Day! We can't wait to see all the children's lovely costumes during their class assembly. As well as this, children will have the opportunity to listen to an author read and give them tips on how to become an amazing writer!

In English we will continue to explore characters and settings through story writing; the children will also have the opportunity to use a range of emotive language when writing a diary entry from the perspective of a character.

In Computing we will be looking at how we can create our own identity online. To do this we will be looking at the key words of copy, alter and modify, what do these words mean and how do they relate to identity?

As scientists, we will be exploring the difference between soluble and insoluble and exploring the process of dissolving. What does it mean to be soluble? How can we test it?

In RSHE, we will be learning all about SMART Targets. What does it mean to set these targets and how do they help us achieve our goals?
