Congratulations to the children who got the happy leaves this week!

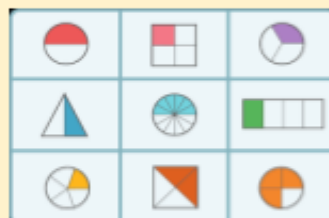
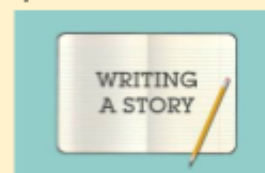


## Our learning..
