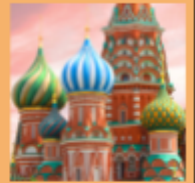


This week...

This week is going to be a chance for all of the children to continue to settle back into school routines and build on their social skills. Please reinforce basic number bonds as well as addition and subtraction within 20. This week on Friday Morning, we will have a Poetry Morning!

While the school was closed we have spent some time giving our outdoor area a makeover. We now have math's station, role play areas and spaces for play based learning. This week the children will be recapping over how to look after things at school and will get a chance to play in our new outdoor environment.

Our foundation subjects will be going ahead as usual in the afternoons this week. We will be looking further at Russia and how it compares to England.
