This week's learning...

As mathematicians we will consolidate our learning by going back and revising the content that we have learned about over the last two terms. This will include addition, subtraction, multiplications, division, fractions, place value, prime numbers, cubed numbers and squared numbers.

This week in English, we will become poets and step into the world of poetry! We will have the opportunity to explore and perform a range of poems as well as identifying the key features of a range of poems. As part of this we will be working towards an online poetry exhibition. This will include online poetry performances and online poetry.

In R.E. we are going to begin our exploration into the Islamic faith. We will discuss the role of the Prophet Muhammed and the Night of Power. We will discuss why this is such a key event in the Islamic Faith and what it means.
