As scientists, we will continue our work on evolution by investigating how different animals mutate and adapt to their new environments in order to survive and reproduce.

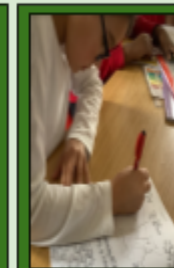
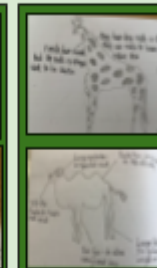
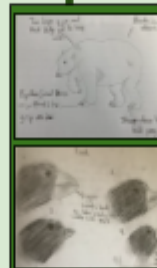
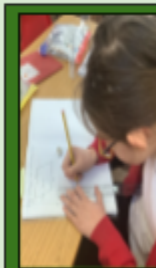
In RE, we will be exploring symbols in the Easter story and will get creative and design our own symbols representing the Easter message.
