This week's happy leaves go to:

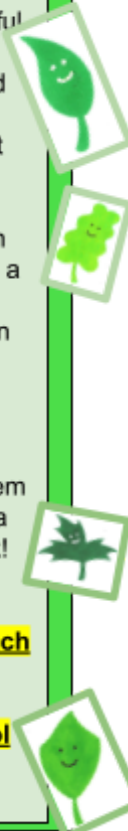
5ON: Aleeza for writing a wonderful reflective poem about her experience of lockdown. She used many creative devices and a full range of poetic features. Excellent work.

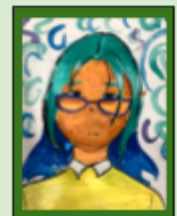
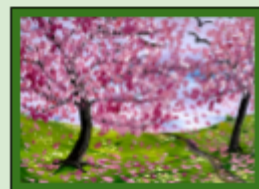
