This week's online learning:

This week in English we will be focusing on Lady Macbeth and how the events in the play caused her to become anxious and confused. What can you remember about Macbeth and the Witches from our previous weeks learning?

As Mathematicians, we will be developing our understanding of money and how we can subtract amounts to work out how much change will be given. We will also begin our new topic of time. Do you know which hand is the minute hand and which is the hour hand?

As Scientists, we will be continuing to explore rocks. This week we will deepen our learning though comparing igneous, sedimentary and metamorphic rocks.

In RSHE this week we continue discussing and thinking about who supports us in our lives, both at home and in school.
