Please continue work on number bonds to 10 and practise counting up in 2s, 5s and 10s.

Our foundation subjects will be going ahead as usual in the afternoons this week. In History, we will be identifying similarities and differences between toys from the Victorian era and the mid 20th century. In Computing we will be learning how to crop and edit a screenshot. Finally, in Science we will be observing the planted seeds and record any changes in our diaries. Why not take a moment to look at all the beautiful plants and flowers out and about. Talk about what you can see e.g. stem, leaves and petals etc.

This term we have been focusing on the topic of 'trust' talk to your child about how to build trust and how trust is shown.
