## This week's learning:

This short week will continue with our Global Treasures topic, please remember school is closed to children on Monday (Bank Holiday) and Thursday (Polling Day). The teachers in year 4 have created a home learning pack for all children to complete on Thursday. The pack will include all the resources they need and it is expected to be returned or handed in online on Friday. Children will have the option to work online if possible or using the paper resources given. In English and Big Reading we will continue to read and learn about Julius Caesar and the Roman Empire. This week in our English lessons the children will be using their plans from last week to create a playscript of one of the scenes from the Julius Caesar story. We are hoping to put them altogether to create a full play script in each class. In our Maths No Problem lessons the children will be learning about rounding decimals. We are also busy learning our times tables to 12, practise these at home with your child and if you can, test them with a couple of quick questions each day. During our foundation lessons we will be concentrating on Design and Technology where the children will design, make and evaluate a Roman chariot. In P.E. the children will start with athletics and will be developing their skills in the art of running consistently and smoothly at different speeds. This will continue alongside music on a Tuesday morning where all children are expected in school in the correct P.E. kit.
