This week's happy leaves go to:

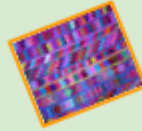

6E: Muaz for his proactive and positive approach towards Maths. He has impressed his teacher by his ability to reason and explain mathematical strategies to others.

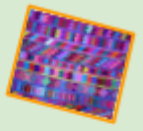
6M: Olasubomi for creating a humorous and creative play script for a scene from Romeo and Juliet. She really captured the essence of the characters!

As writers, we will be editing our scripts and then we will be using our oracy skills to perform our scripts by acting out the scene in groups.

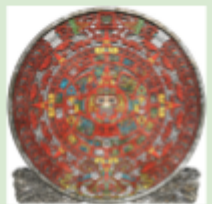
As mathematicians, we will be continuing our learning on number and the four operations. We will be revising place value to make sure that we are all confident on this.

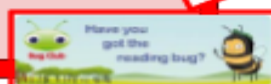
