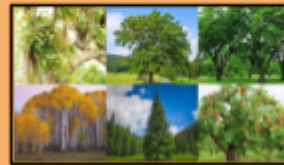
This week...

We are continuing our learning in the afternoons with our foundation subjects. In History, we will be comparing materials between toys from the Victorian era and the mid 20th century. In Computing we will be learning how to insert a picture into Google Slides. In Science, we will be learning about different types of trees. Why not go for a tree hunt when you walk in your local park? Can you spot different types of trees? Some of our plants are beginning to show a small shoot. In RSHE, we will be learning about how to be confident and show a 'can-do' attitude. We want our children to be resilient and to never give up!
