## This week's online learning:

This week in English we will continue to focus on the features of a play script, which we will then use to rewrite a scene from Macbeth. Can you remember the features?

As Mathematicians, we will be delving into our new topic of graphs and data! If you were to count the number of people on a train, what chart would be the most effective to present this data?
