This week's learning:

This week's learning will see the children begin a new cycle in their English lessons. They will be learning more about the Romans and creating their own fact files and biographies of Julius Caesar and the Roman Empire. In maths, the children will complete the topic on decimals and prepare for the next topic on money. As scientists we will continue learning about humans and this week we will be learning all about human teeth. In History we will be using the Now PressPlay interactive resource we have to learn more about Roman Britain, the Roman army, Boudicca, the legacy of the Romans and the Iceni rebellion. Our Spanish lessons continue to be enjoyed by everyone in Year 4, class teachers and T.As are learning the language alongside the children. Ask your child what Spanish they know, we have been learning how to ask someone's name, how they are, where they live. We have recently been learning names of colours and animals and how to use these in a sentence. A very busy week is ahead for the children and alongside these lessons they will be reading, learning spellings, times tables and in laughology all about self confidence and support. This week we will be asking the children why they are awesome and how they can show this in their body language. In P.E. the children will start with athletics and will be developing their skills in the art of running consistently and smoothly at different speeds. This will continue alongside music on a Tuesday morning where all children are expected in school in the correct P.E. kit. We have a very busy half term ahead and it is important children attend school everyday .

Don't forget!

As you are aware children are allowed to bring a bottle of water into school everyday to help them stay hydrated throughout the day. Please do not send your child to school with a glass bottle as they are very easily smashed when dropped.
