## This week's learning:

This week in English we will begin to look at factual information around the Stone Age, bringing all the information we have been learning about in History together. We will also be conducting newspaper interviews to help us write our own newspaper reports on the Stone Age.

As Mathematicians, we will be collecting and representing data using tally charts and bar graphs. Could you collect your family members favourite ice-cream flavour and record this in a tally chart?

In Big Reading, we will finish reading *Macbeth* exploring the key morals and messages found within the story.

As Historians, we are now moving onto the Bronze Age and comparing it to the Stone Age.

In R.E, we are exploring Sikh sayings and meaningful quotes from the holy book. We will analyse their importance and explore the messages behind them.

In R.S.H.E, we are exploring confidence levels and reflecting on how confident we are at different subjects and tasks.
