This week's learning:

In maths this week, the children will begin a new topic and will be learning about money. They will use their knowledge of decimals to compare and round amounts to the nearest pound. As writers they are beginning to plan a Roman fact file making sure they have researched the information they need and can set out a fact file using the correct features. As scientists we will begin learning about animals including herbivores, carnivores and omnivores. The children will group animals according to their diet and will also be creating a food diet for zoo animals. In History we will be looking at the legacy of the Romans, thinking carefully about how they impact life today. Your child will be creating a presentation which will be uploaded onto Google Classroom. Make sure you have a look at their fantastic work. In R.S.H.E. the children will recognise a can-do attitude in others and use this to help them challenge themselves. This will link back to body language in lesson 4 and teach the children how we can tell emotions from this.

In P.E. the children have been learning how to play cricket, they will choose and use batting and throwing skills to make the game hard for their opponents, work well as a team to make it hard for the batter and beginning to think about tactics to work as a team.

Don't forget!
