As mathematicians, this week children will be exploring and solving a range of problems involving angles and investigating the different types of angles inside regular polygons.

As readers, the children will continue following the story of Gunner, the Viking Boy and exploring the hurdles that he faces.

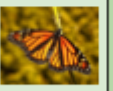
As writers, the children will now begin planning and writing their very own non-chronological report based on the Vikings. They will have the opportunity to use the research that they gathered and the toolkit that they created last week to support them in creating their own report.

In R.E. we be looking at how different religions worship God and why some people believe in more than one god.

In RHSE, we will be discussing the different types of support networks available to us and the impact support can have on our life.

As scientists, the children will be looking at the life cycle of a flowering plant and comparing it to the life cycle of a butterfly.
