**Ask your child what they think they could do to try to receive one!**



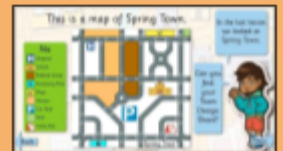
## This week...

This week marks the start of our Healthy Hearts topic where we will be exploring how to keep our bodies and minds healthy. Have a talk to your child about what they might already know about keeping healthy.

In Maths we are starting to look at division. You could have a go at sharing things at home? E.g. Share out some grapes or the plates for dinner. How many will each person get?

Our foundation subjects will be going ahead as usual in the afternoons this week. In Science this week will be thinking about how our ears help us to hear. We will be taking a closer look at how our ears receive sound. In R.E. we will be thinking about 'What it means to be a Hindu.' In computing we will be learning about algorithms and how they can help us. Finally in Geography will be thinking about our local area and begin to map out the special places around the school.

This term our whole school focus will be on the word 'support'. How can we develop positive relationships by showing support? Talk to your child at home about support. How can it be shown and how do we receive it? What an exciting week we have ahead of us!
