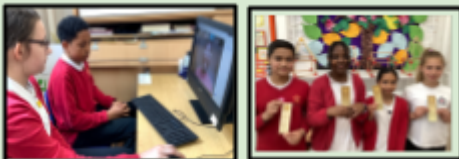


## STAR moments

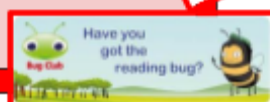
