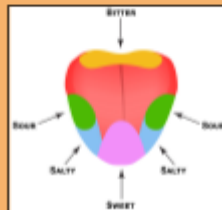
This week...

This week we will continue with our Healthy Hearts topic where we will be exploring how to keep our bodies and minds healthy. How do you keep healthy?

In Maths we are starting to look at fractions. You could have a go at cutting some paper into halves or quarters!

Our foundation subjects will be going ahead as usual in the afternoons this week. In Science this week will be thinking about how our taste buds help us recognise different tastes. In R.E. we will be learning more about Hinduism and their God, Krishna. In computing we will start using the BeeBots and creating a map for them to travel on.
