This week, we will start our new topic **Healthy Hearts**.

English: We will be reading 'What's going on in my head' and exploring features of an explanation text. In our Big Writing day, children will be producing a caption about meditation.




Maths: We will be revisiting addition and subtraction procedures to embed our understanding of using different strategies to solve mathematical problems.

Art: This term we will be looking at a style of Art called Pop Art. Children will be incorporating this style of art to create their own plates using clay.

Science: We will be investigating what makes us healthy. Children will learn to draw their own conclusion through Now Press Play experience.
